2014 Lessons Learned

Challenges

 Tracking Spending has been quite difficult

(no regular reports)
(not clear how items are covered in reports)

We were too operational

- Board had to sign off every single item
- Working with suppliers is timeintensive

Actions

Align Budget with LF cost and income codes

(LF to ensure that there are regular reports)

- Start with one (or two) strategic initiatives (e.g. OpenStack WG)
- We changed budget rules
- Consolidate suppliers (e.g. maintenance)

2014 Spending Overview (estimates)

What we planned

AR & PR : \$100K

Test Framework : \$165K

Website + Marketing : \$34K

Developers: \$60K

Operational: \$6K

Total (excluding G&A): \$365K

What we spent

AR & PR : \$100K

Test Framework: \$78K
 (cheaper than planned + delays)

 Website + Marketing: \$25K (includes user events)

Developers: \$39
 (includes developer events)

Operational: \$5K

Total (excluding G&A): \$247

2015 Accounts

- Expected carryover from 2014: \$300K
- Expected income in 2015: \$325K
- Plan for spending in 2015 of \$370K without G&A fee (\$425K with)
- Would leave us with \$200K reserve

2015 Ongoing charges (already agreed)

- AR/PR resource: \$100K
 - Proposal: add \$5K slack for fees, other promo projects
 - Would get us to: \$105K
- COLO hosting: \$24K (including estimated power cost)
 - Proposal: add one more rack (with set-up \$26K) in 2015
 - Would get us to: \$50K
- Test Infra maintenance: \$17K (not yet signed)
 - Consider finding a different supplier who can also sysadmin for lists, wiki, ...
 - Budget a total of \$30K for both
- Runrate of: \$185K per year (rest \$165K)

2015 Operational Initiatives

- New HW for COLO : \$80K (could expand if needed)
 - May need some Windows licenses
- Face-2-face meetings: \$5K
- Training, OPW, GSoC, Travel Stipends: \$35K
- Support User Events and Initiatives : \$15K
- Developer Events Slush Fund: \$30K
 - Estimated cost for Dev Summit and Dev Meeting \$57.3K (attached)
 - Assuming \$200 ticket price and 30K of sponsorship we may have to subsidize by around \$10K
- Total of: \$165K
- Reserve of \$20K for additional items

Strategic Initiatives

The key here is that most of these, e.g. an OpenStack initiative or an initiative to develop boot-less Xen updates is primarily achieved by AB members collaborating more closely

BUT: there may be some funding implications

Examples:

- Running an OpenStack CI loop may require buying AMIs from a cloud provider
- Beefing up the vendor directory may require hiring temp staff to reach out to Xen vendors and signing them up pro-actively
- Etc.
